- **National Charities:** £30 (*No tombola permitted*)
- **Craft Stalls (Handmade Items):** £30 (includes 6ft trestle table)

How to Apply for a Craft Stall

Step 1 – Complete the Application Form

Download and fill out the application form (included below) and return via:

- **Email:** info@crowleshow.org.uk (please use 'Craft Stall' as the subject)

Step 2 - Approval when we have had chance to review your application form (we always monitor how many traders sell similar items for every ones enjoyment of the show) we will email you to let you know and attach an invoice for payment.

We endeavour to reply promptly to everyone however please bare in mind the committee all do this on a volunteer basis around work and businesses and so response times may vary

Step 3 – Payment.

Payment must be made within 7 days of receiving the invoice to secure your space.

Step 4 – Public Liability Insurance

Send us a copy of your current **Public Liability Insurance certificate**, showing cover for **19th July 2026**. If your insurance is due for renewal prior to the show we do NOT need a copy of the policy that doesn't cover the show, however if you can please pop us an email with the renewal date we will add it to our system so that we can freeze the system from chasing you until then. Documents can be sent via email or post to the same address above.



Trading Agreement & Key Information

By booking a stall at the Crowle Agricultural Show, you agree to our Show Rules and Health & Safety Policy.

Please note the following important terms:

- **Merchandise Restrictions:**

Traders must only sell items listed in their application. We limit duplicate stalls to maintain variety.

Unauthorised trading of different goods may result in removal from the show without refund.
- Anyone selling alcohol must also provide a TENs certificate from the Council
- **Show Day Access:**
 - Access to the field from **6:00 AM** on show day
 - Early access **by arrangement only** with Trade Secretary, Darren or Show Chair Jessica
 - **All vehicles on the show field must be stationary by 9:30 AM** and may not move until **after 4:00 PM** for safety reasons
- **Documentation & Payment Deadline:**
 - All documents and payments **must be submitted before the deadline** to secure a pitch
 - No stalls will be secured until **payment is received**
 - Public liability insurance (and proof of such) is mandatory for trading at the show, please note that failure to send proof of this will forfeit your position at the show and your pitch fees will not be returned.
- **Refund Policy:**
 - Stall fees are **non-refundable** unless the show is cancelled
- **Waste Policy:**
 - All trade waste must be removed
 - Excessive waste left behind may incur additional charges
- **Food Traders:**
 - Must display up-to-date **Food Hygiene Certification**
- **Zero Tolerance Policy:**
 - We operate a **zero tolerance** policy towards abuse of any volunteers or committee members. Such behaviour may result in removal from the premises and future attendances been blocked at the discretion of the show Chair Person.
